TERMS and CONDITIONS

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into, as of the signature date shown below between ChicagoWorldCup, LLC and the Exhibiting Company ("The Exhibitor") listed herein.

By signing this contract, The Exhibitor agrees to the terms in this binding agreement and understands that The Exhibitor is submitting an application to reserve exhibit space and to participate in the "Chicago World Cup Festival & Chicago French Bastille Day" at Soldier Field in Chicago, on July 11, 2010. The Exhibitor understands and agrees that the booth space will be assigned by ChicagoWorldCup, LLC as specified in this document. The Exhibitor understands and agrees that ChicagoWorldCup, LLC cannot guarantee that it will be able to satisfy The Exhibitor's specific location requirements. Further, The Exhibitor understands and agrees that prior to June 11, 2010, refunds will be given less a \$150 cancellation fee and that no refunds will be given after June 11, 2010.

The parties agree as follows:

1. The Exhibitor subscribes for booth space at the "Chicago World Cup Festival & Chicago French Bastille Day" at Soldier Field on July, 11th, 2010 for the designated fee. Booth space rental shall include one (1) 10' x 10' booth space.
2. The Exhibitor assumes the entire responsibility and liability for losses, damages, and claims arising out of The Exhibitor's activities at the Soldier Field premises and agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless SMG, Chicago Park District and their respective officers, directors, agents, employees and the ChicagoWorldCup, LLC and its respective agents, officers, directors, employees and volunteers from any and all such losses, damages, and claims.
3. ChicagoWorldCup, LLC, SMG and the Chicago Park District may employ an attorney or attorneys to protect their rights, for which The Exhibitor shall pay ChicagoWorldCup, LLC, SMG and the Chicago Park District, reasonable attorney fees and expenses incurred.
4. The Exhibitor understands and agrees that ChicagoWorldCup, LLC, SMG and the Chicago Park District do not maintain insurance covering The Exhibitor's property. The Exhibitor's property is the sole responsibility of The Exhibitor. The Exhibitor shall obtain, at its own expense, adequate insurance against any such injury, loss or damage. The Exhibitor waives the right of subrogation by its insurance carrier(s) to recover losses sustained under The Exhibitor's insurance contracts for real and personal property.
5. ChicagoWorldCup, LLC, SMG and the Chicago Park District shall not be responsible for loss, damage or injury to person or property that may be suffered by The Exhibitor, or The Exhibitor's employee, from any cause whatsoever arising out of participation in the Show prior, during or subsequent to the exhibition and releases and agrees to indemnify, and hold harmless and defend the aforesaid, and each of them, from any and all claims for such loss, damage, and injury.
6. Shipping to the Soldier Field premises is not allowed by individual companies. Shipping must be arranged through the ChicagoWorldCup, LLC.
7. ChicagoWorldCup, LLC and Soldier Field do not provide equipment, decorations and related services, guard services, labor or carpenters; storage of exhibit materials; special lighting or electrical power; gas and water supply.
8. ChicagoWorldCup, LLC in its sole discretion reserves the right to deny participation in the Show to entities that promote, sell, or represent products or services that conflict with ChicagoWorldCup, LLC policies and/or determined not to be in the best interest of ChicagoWorldCup, LLC.
9. The Exhibitor agrees not to create any dangerous or hazardous situations including but not limited to traffic, light, noise or other infringements that interfere with the use of any other Exhibitor's space or traffic flow. The Exhibitor causing such damage shall be responsible for any and all damage(s) incurred by ChicagoWorldCup, LLC, SMG, the Chicago Park District and/or other exhibitor(s). ChicagoWorldCup, LLC reserves the right to restrict or close any exhibit at the Show which, because of noise, method of operation, materials, or any other reason, in the sole discretion of ChicagoWorldCup, LLC becomes objectionable or consists of products or services that are inappropriate for the visitors, without liability for any refunds or other exhibit expenses incurred or alleged, for any reason, loss or damage including but not limited to actual or consequential damages.
10. Exhibitor agrees to confine its employees, products and activities within the boundaries of its space. The Exhibitor shall not distribute/display circulars/promotional materials/flyers/products outside of its contracted exhibit space unless The Exhibitor has obtained prior express written authorization from ChicagoWorldCup, LLC. A violation of this provision shall subject The Exhibitor to pay ChicagoWorldCup, LLC an additional charge of \$1000.
11. Gasoline-operated vehicles/equipment on display shall have no fuel in the tank. Fuel tank caps shall be locked or taped and battery cables must be disconnected or taped, and the battery removed. No gasoline or other type of fuel-operated motor may be operated inside the exhibit hall at the Show.
12. In compliance with the Chicago Park District regulations, The Exhibitor shall not sell/distribute/serve alcoholic beverages and/or food products for consumption at the Show.
13. In the event the show is interrupted or prevented from being held for any reason beyond the control of ChicagoWorldCup, LLC, this Contract for Exhibit Space shall terminate and The Exhibitor shall not be entitled to a refund for any fees paid and further waives any claim against ChicagoWorldCup, LLC for damage of any kind or nature of such termination.
